Important Extracurricular Policies:

- All registrations requested after September 24 must be sent to extracurricular@hptaonline.com, are subject to a \$50 late fee, will be reviewed by September 28, and are not guaranteed placement.
- If the HPTA cancels a class due to low enrollment you will receive a full refund or you will have the option of switching to another open class.
- No other refunds given except for medical issues. Medical refunds will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
- Refunds will be given by check by October 18, 2010.
- Prompt pick-up is required for participation in HPTA extracurricular classes. On the first occasion of pick-up occurring 15 or more minutes late, a warning will be given. An additional late pick-up will result in the child being withdrawn from the class, without refund, and the child will not be permitted to register for the following session of extracurricular classes.
- Extracurricular Discipline Policy: All children are expected to cooperate with the instructors and other children. Any child who is considered disruptive may be asked to leave after a conference with parents. The HPTA reserve the right to cancel enrollment, with no refunds, at any time due to disruptive behavior as determined by the instructor and HPTA.
