In addition to the grade level Listservs, we highly recommend that you sign up for the E-Flyers Listserv. E-Flyers replace traditional backpack flyers, which are no longer sent home. E-Flyers are your connection to community groups and events, such as scouting, sports, plays, concerts, and HPTA events.
